Dear Members,

Well, here we are again, for the twentyninth year touching base with those of you that have made our quest possible. With your help and support, we have grown and flourished.

Just this October we have added a "Senior Center" to our adoption shelter and an annex for cats with FIV and FeLV. Our Senior Center caters to elderly cats, over the age of ten, whose owners have passed away or are unable to care for their pet due to health issues. We are very excited to offer this to these cats. Our caring staff and board of directors work tirelessly for the health and welfare of those in our care. It's a hard job. Viruses are easily spread, and we are always preemptively fighting them.





The number of stray cats and kittens seems to grow with our county. We take as many as we can care for, but it's never enough. Believe me, it weighs on us.

So far in 2025 we have received 109 cats and kittens. As of this writing we have adopted out 61 cats this year. At the time of this writing, we currently have more than 30 kittens available at the shelter who are need of their forever homes. We hope to find them all homes, and of course, sterilize them before embarking on their new and happy lives. Again, it is because of your faith in us and your support that we are able to help so many. Thank you.

Whisker Wisdom: Summer Tips for Happy Cats

Keeping your house cat happy and comfortable during the summer months is essential! Here are some helpful tips:

- Hydration is Key Ensure your cat has access to fresh, cool water at all times. Consider using a cat water fountain to encourage drinking.
- Cooling Mats Provide a cooling mat or a chilled towel for your cat to lounge on, especially if your home gets warm.
- Air Circulation Use fans or air conditioning to maintain a comfortable indoor temperature.
- Frozen Treats Offer frozen catsafe treats, such as ice cubes made from tuna water, to help them cool down.
- Grooming Regular brushing helps remove excess fur and prevents overheating, especially for longhaired cats.
- Shade and Cool Spots Make sure your cat has access to shaded areas or cool surfaces like tile floors.
- Playtime Adjustments Schedule playtime during cooler parts of the day, such as early morning or late evening.
- Preventative Care Keep up with flea, tick, and heartworm prevention, as these pests are more active in summer.

How You Can Help

1. Spay & Neuter

Preventing unwanted litters is key to controlling the cat population. Spay/neuter your pets and support trapneuter-return (TNR) programs.

2. Foster a Kitten

Fostering provides a temporary, loving home for kittens until they are ready for adoption. It's life-saving and rewarding.

3. Donate to Save Lives

Kitten season strains our resources. Additional donations of kitten formula, food, bedding, and medical supplies ensure we can continue our rescue efforts.

4. Adopt & Advocate
